HTTP REQUEST METHODS

GET	<i>Retrieve a resource</i>
POST	<i>Create a resource</i>
PATCH	<i>Update an existing resource (use instead of PUT, which replaces an existing resource)</i>
DELETE	<i>Delete a resource</i>
HEAD	<i>Retrieve the headers for a resource</i>

HTTP STATUS CODES

200	<i>Okay</i>
301	<i>Moved permanently</i>
302	<i>Moved temporarily</i>
400	<i>Bad request</i>
403	<i>Forbidden</i>
404	<i>Not found</i>
500	<i>Internal server error</i>

FETCH REQUEST

```
fetch(url).then(function(response) {  
  // check if request was successful  
}).then(function(response) {  
  // do something with the response  
});
```

JQUERY AJAX

`$.get(url);` *loads data from the url using an HTTP GET request*

`$.ajax({...});` *performs an Ajax request based on properties you specify in the object passed as a parameter*
